- 1) Innovation class – Want to experiment with a bio-fueled vehicle, a plug-in hybrid electric vehicle, or some other innovative alternative transportation solution? The new Innovation Class allows teams to build and compete in vehicles that break the mold. - 2) Junior Solar Sprint Competition, sponsored by One World Sustainable Energy Corporation, lets middle school students pit their solar-powered electric creations against each other in exciting head-to-head racing.
